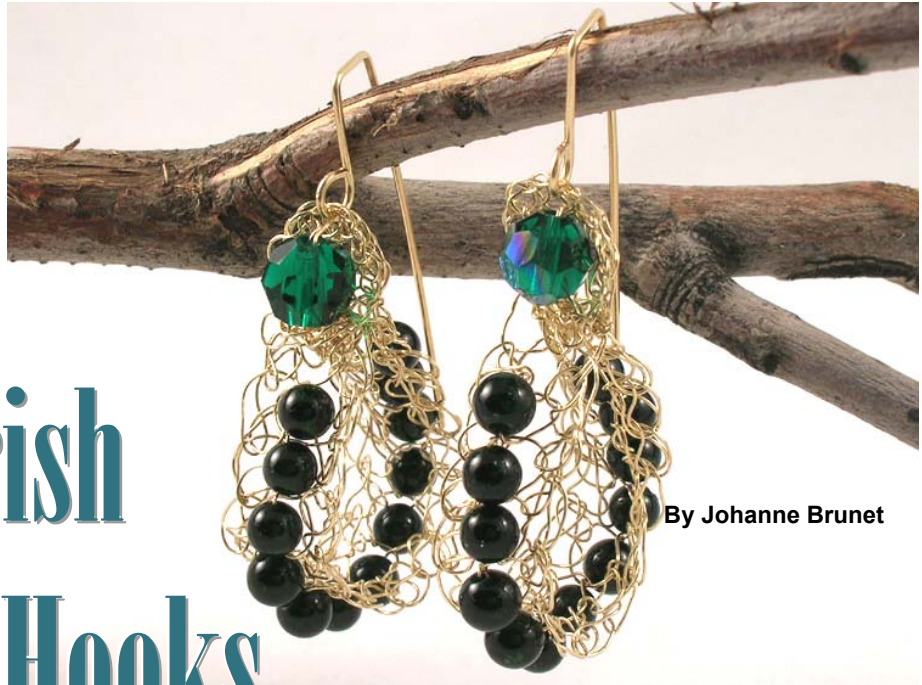

# Squarish Ear Hooks

(For hooks only. See Loopy Earrings tutorial for whole earrings)

**Prerequisite:** None

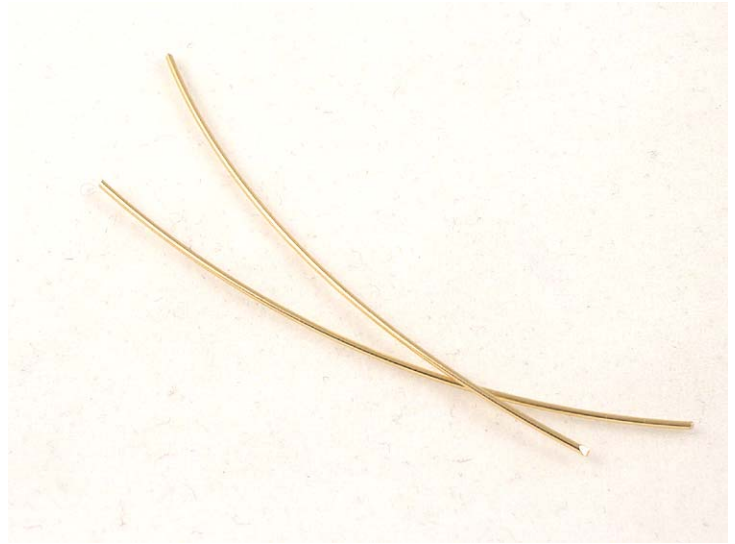
**Crochet knowledge:** None

**NOTE :** You can zoom in this document at 200%, and still retain a good image definition.

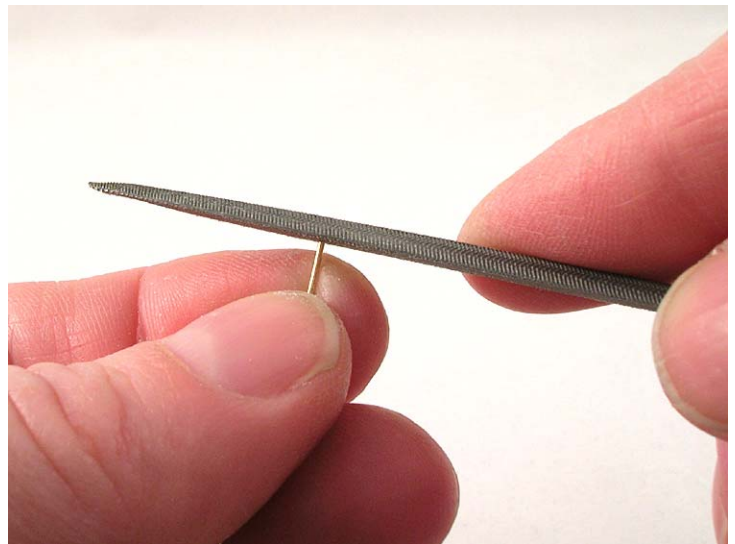
**Materials:**

- 4 inches of 22 ga half-hard round wire
- flat-nose pliers
- round-nose pliers
- cutters
- metal file

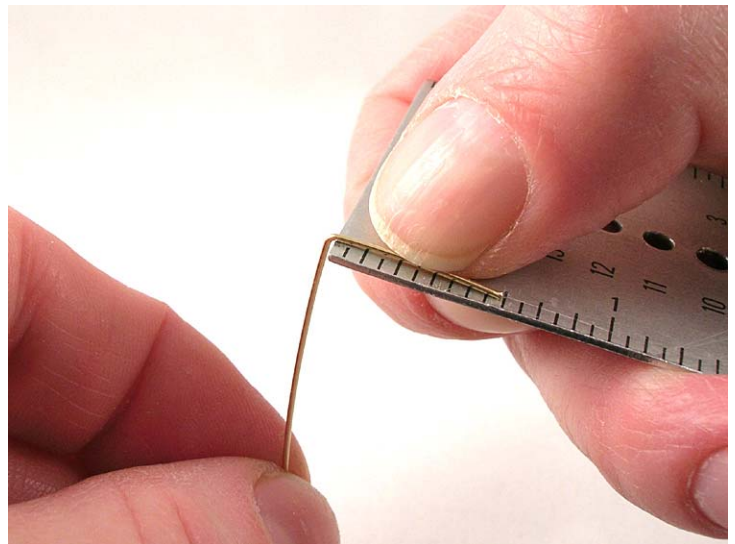
1. Cut the 22 ga half-hard wire in two lengths of 2 inches each.



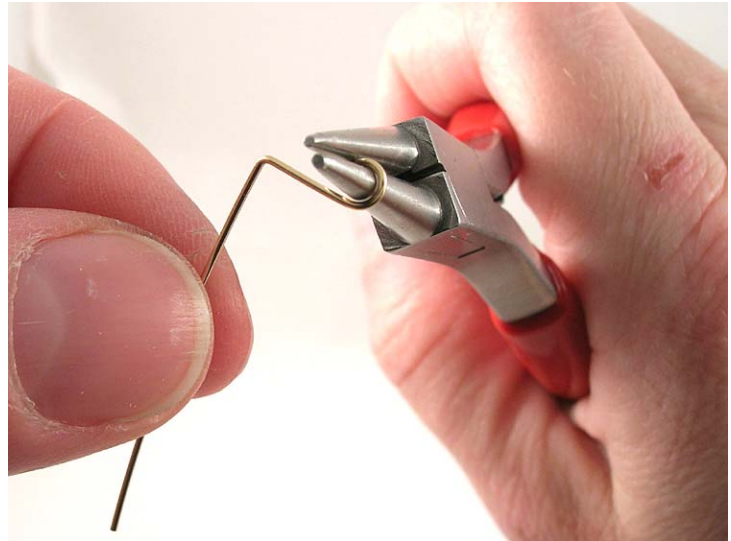
2. File all ends carefully, to make them really smooth or use a cup bur.



3. Make a 90° bend in the wire at 5/8 inch of one end.



4. With the round-nose pliers, make a small loop at the shortest end of the "L" figure.

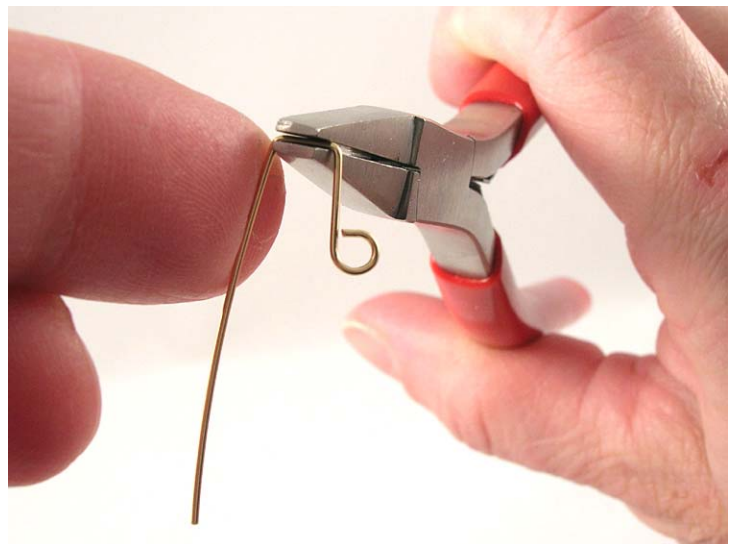


5. Using the width of your flat-nose pliers as a gauge, make another 90° bend to transform the "L" into a squarish "J" figure.

Repeat for the other ear hook.

Make sure that they have the same shape and length, cutting off any excess if necessary, filing the cut ends again.

Attach to earrings.
